



**GORDIE HOWE INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE**

**CLARK STREET  
LONG - TERM CLOSURE**

**THE PROJECT**

The Gordie Howe International Bridge project between Windsor, ON and Detroit, MI will help move goods and people more efficiently at this important trade gateway. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public private partnership (P3) which will see Bridging North America design, build, finance, operate and maintain the bridge.

Starting February 28, 2022, Bridging North America will temporarily close a section of Clark Street, and the entrance-ramps and exit-ramps to the Clark Street bridge over I-75, to support the reconstruction of the Clark Street approaches and intersections. These closures will remain in place until May 20, 2022.

- Clark Street will be closed between Fort Street and the I-75 Service Drive.
- The Clark Street entrance-ramp to northbound I-75 and the Clark Street exit-ramp at southbound I-75 will be closed.
- Detour routes are in place and include the following:

**Local Traffic:**

Local traffic will be detoured around the Clark Street closure by using Junction Avenue to access Vernor Highway or Fort Street.

**Southbound I-75 to Clark Street (Southbound Exit-Ramp Detour):**

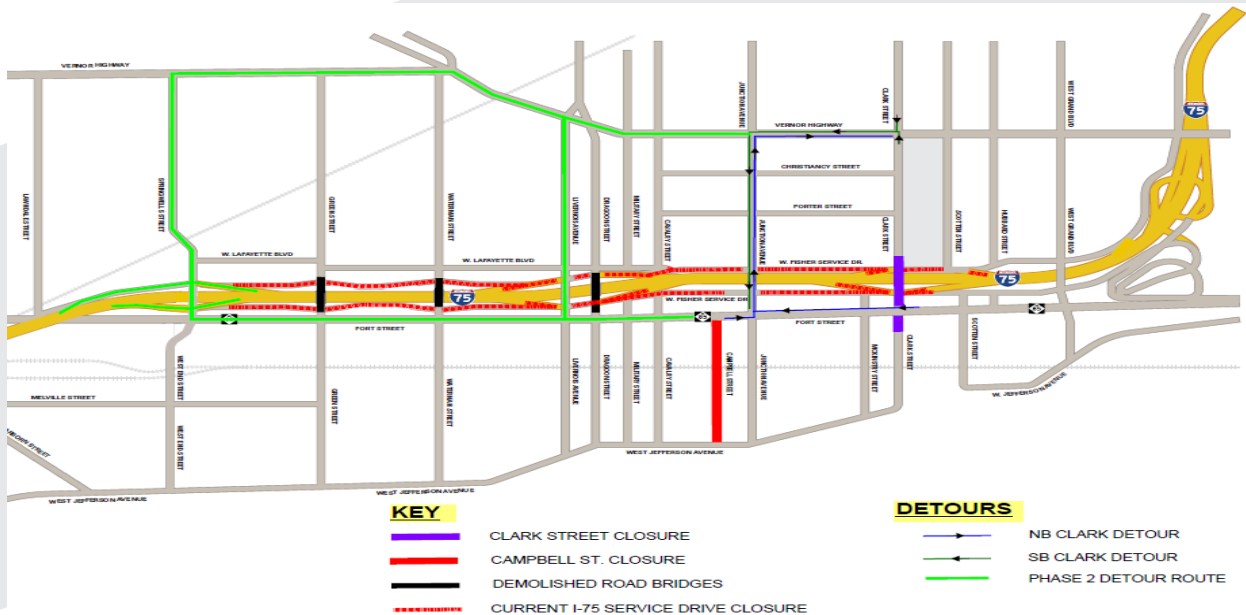
Southbound I-75 traffic heading to Clark Street will exit via the Springwells exit-ramp to Springwells Street, head east on Vernor Highway, head east to Clark Street.

**Westbound Fort Street to Northbound I-75 (Northbound Entrance-Ramp Detour):**

Westbound Fort Street traffic at Clark Street heading to northbound I-75 will continue west on Fort Street, and north to the Springwells Street on-ramp to access northbound I-75.
