JUNCTION STREET ROAD BRIDGE CLOSURE

THE PROJECT


The Gordie Howe International Bridge project between Windsor, ON and Detroit, MI will help move goods and people more efficiently at this important trade gateway. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public private partnership (P3) which will see Bridging North America design, build, finance, operate and maintain the bridge. Bridging North America will close Junction Street road bridge between the northbound and southbound I-75 Service Drives over a long-term period beginning Wednesday, June 29, 2022.

Long-Term Closure of Junction Street

- On Wednesday, June 29, 2022, at 7 a.m., the Junction Street road bridge between the northbound and southbound I-75 Service Drives will close over a long-term period.
- The traveling public will be detoured to Fort Street, which has been fully re-opened to traffic.

Additionally, northbound and southbound I-75, from Springwells Street to Clark Street, will close over a weekend to support the demolition work of the Junction Street road bridge and also to set new girders on I-75 as part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project. Planning is underway for possible demolition to occur over the July 8, 2022, weekend. Information regarding the demolition weekend will be shared once details are confirmed.
