

COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION INVESTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

The Neighbourhood Infrastructure Strategy of the Community Benefits Plan includes a commitment to provide an annual investment allowance for community organizations located in or serving Sandwich/west Windsor or Delray/Southwest Detroit residents for a five-year duration from 2020 – 2024. Applications for funding ranging from \$1,000 to \$25,000* are accepted on an annual basis for proposed initiatives like events, programming and infrastructure improvements that will benefit the neighbourhoods closest to the project. 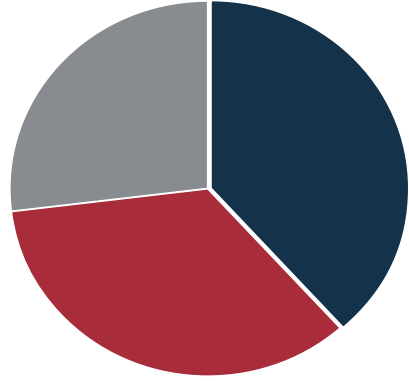
