#### Windsor-Detroit Cross-River Tour Survey - Feedback Wanted

The Windsor-Detroit Cross-River Tour is an international Community Benefits Plan initiative that celebrates the unique culture, history and diversity of the Sandwich/west Windsor and Delray/Southwest Detroit communities through interpretive signage that will be placed along pedestrian and cycling paths on the lands surrounding the Canadian and US Ports of Entry.

The project team has worked closely with the Community Stories Committee, a group made up of local community members and subject-matter experts, as well as other historical and cultural associations in the region to identify a shortlist of topics under consideration for inclusion on the tour signage.

The project team is collecting public feedback through a survey to help prioritize topics for possible inclusion in the Windsor-Detroit Cross-River Tour. It is anticipated that the project team will install between six-to-eight signs around each Port of Entry prior to the opening of the bridge. The survey is open until April 6, 2023, at 4:30 P.M.


## Start of Stay Cable Installation on the Gordie Howe International Bridge
