

PARTIAL CLOSURE OF SANDWICH STREET BETWEEN ETR AND CHAPPELL AVENUE

THE PROJECT

As part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, just over three kilometres of Sandwich Street will be reconstructed by Bridging North America (BNA). Sandwich Street reconstruction will stretch from south of the Rosedale Avenue roundabout past Ojibway Parkway to McKee Avenue. Once complete, the City of Windsor will be responsible for maintaining the street.

Anticipated to start September 5, 2023, Bridging North America will close southbound Sandwich Street between Essex Terminal Railway (ETR) tracks and Chappell Avenue. One lane of northbound traffic will remain in place.

During this closure, businesses located on this section of Sandwich Street will be accessible via northbound Sandwich Street only. This closure is anticipated to be in place for 14 weeks in duration.

Sandwich Street Detour Routes



Northbound traffic:

No detour is required. One lane of traffic will remain open.

Southbound traffic:

Southbound traffic will detour to Huron Church Road:

Vehicular traffic will turn east on Prince Road and follow it to Huron Church Road.

Commercial (truck) traffic will turn east on Prince Road and then east on Tecumseh Road to Huron Church Road.

Once traffic has reached Huron Church Road the detour ends. Huron Church Road can be followed to reach the intended destination of E.C. Row Expressway, Highway 401, Ojibway Parkway or addresses on Sandwich Street within the construction work area.
