

As progress continues across all four components of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, the team recognizes the importance of celebrating accomplishments along the way, and there is a lot of recent activity to be proud of.


- The <u>US bridge tower</u> reached its full height of 220 m/722 ft in August 2023. The Canadian tower is anticipated to reach its full height in October 2023.
- Half of the 55 bridge deck segments over the Detroit River have now been installed.
- With 116 of the 216 total stay cables connecting the towers and decks in place, the team is counting down the last 100 stay cables to be installed.
- The fourth and final <u>road bridge</u> reconstructed as part of Michigan Interchange activities reopened in August connecting communities over I-75.
- Since the official start of construction on October 5, 2018, over 10 million hours of work have been logged and over 10,000 people have been oriented to work on the project.
