ENVIRONMENTAL, SOCIAL AND GOVERNANCE PLAN QUARTERLY REPORT - FALL 2023





The Gordie Howe International Bridge project is a new border transportation system being constructed between Windsor, Ontario and Detroit, Michigan, including the bridge, two state-of-the-art ports of entry and a connection into the US interstate highway system. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) and working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public-private partnership (P3) with Bridging North America.

Published in 2023, WDBA's ESG Plan has consolidated efforts undertaken since the start of WDBAs operations in 2015 into a roadmap that actively supports the creation of a thriving and sustainable future. The Plan's activities align with WDBA's four anchors of ESG: Environment, Community, Corporate Culture and Corporate Conduct.

With a commitment to transparent and accountable implementation, the project team is proud to report on ESG accomplishments through this quarterly report.

WDBA acknowledges that the land where the Gordie Howe International Bridge project is being constructed sits on Anishinaabe Territory. The Anishinaabeg in the Windsor area are known as the Three Fires Confederacy which consists of the Ojibwe, Odawa, and Potawatomi Nations. This land has also served as a place of refuge for the Huron/Wendat people.



In November 2023, WDBA staff came together for a community clean-up at Malden Park in Windsor, Ontario. Led by WDBA's ESG, Health and Safety and Corporate Culture Committees in collaboration with municipal staff, small teams set out to clear the park of litter and debris. These efforts not only resulted in a visibly cleaner park but also fostered a sense of community and teamwork amongst participants. The team is proud to support the communities in which we work and where the Gordie Howe International Bridge is being constructed and will operate.
