Traffic updates - What you need to know

As construction of the Michigan Interchange begins, Bridging North America will temporarily implement partial road closures:

- The right lane and right shoulder of northbound South Calvary Street within 50' south of Norfolk Southern Railway will be closed on August 24, 2019, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Bridging North America will permanently implement closures on these roadways on August 22, 2019, at 7 a.m. for the construction of the US Port of Entry (POE) of the Gordie Howe International Bridge.

- Waterman Street northbound and southbound between South Street and Norfolk Southern Railway will permanently close on August 22, 2019, at 7 a.m.
- Rademacher Street northbound and southbound between South Street to Norfolk Southern Railway will permanently close on August 22, 2019, at 7 a.m.
- Reid Street northbound and southbound between South Street to Hesse Street will permanently close on August 22, 2019, at 7 a.m.
- Crawford Street northbound and southbound between South Street to Norfolk Southern Railway will permanently close on August 22, 2019, at 7 a.m.
- Livernois Avenue southbound between South Street to Norfolk Southern Railway will permanently close on August 22, 2019, at 7 a.m.
- Hesse Street eastbound and westbound between Rademacher Street to Reid Street will permanently close on August 22, 2019, at 7 a.m.
- South Street eastbound and westbound between Post Street to Dragoon Street will permanently close on August 22, 2019, at 7 a.m.
