Michigan Interchange I-75 Closures

As construction of the Michigan Interchange begins, Bridging North America will temporarily implement partial closures on the following streets for construction activities:

All lanes on the southbound Service Drive will close between Green Street and Govin Street, beginning
Tuesday, February 11, 2020. The closure will be in place for approximately eight months to accommodate
for excavation, freeway widening and ramp/embankment construction. Access to Springwells Street
businesses and adjacent residential roadways will be available via Green Street to W. Lafayette Blvd and
from Springwells Street southbound.

I-75 Northbound

- Mobile closures on I-75 northbound and southbound from Schaefer Avenue to Michigan Avenue beginning March 6 to August 31, 2020, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. as needed. Closures will be less than one hour in duration during these time frames for performance of maintenance activities.
- The left lane and shoulder of I-75 northbound will be closed between Springwells Street to Clark Street on April 21, 2020, starting 5 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- The right lane and shoulder of I-75 northbound will be closed between Springwells Street to Clark Street on April 22, 2020, starting 5 a.m. to 6 p.m.

I-75 Northbound Service Drive

- All lanes on I-75 Service Drive northbound will close between Waterman Street to Livernois Avenue from April 4 until May 1, 2020, from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily.
- I-75 Service Drive northbound will close between the I-75 northbound Clark Street exit ramp to the I-75 northbound Clark Street on ramp from March 31 to May 8, 2020.

Michigan Interchange I-75 Closures

As construction of the Michigan Interchange begins, Bridging North America will temporarily implement partial closures on the following streets for construction activities:

- Northbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Waterman Street to Livernois Avenue from April 17 to August 20, from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily. This will change from a daily closure to a full closure on April 20.
- The left lane and middle lane on I-75 Service Drive northbound will close between Livernois Avenue to Dragoon Street from April 17 to August 20. This will change from a daily closure to a full closure on April 20.

Northbound I-75 Service Drive Detour: Northbound I-75 Service Drive motorists will take Waterman Street southbound, turn left on Fort Street eastbound, turn left on Dragoon Street northbound and then continue on northbound I-75 Service Drive

- The left lane and middle lane on I-75 Service Drive northbound will close between Livernois Avenue to Dragoon Street from April 17 to August 20. This will change from a daily closure to a full closure on April 20.
- The I-75 Service Drive northbound will close from the Clark Street off-ramp to the on-ramp starting April 20 to May 9, 2020.

I-75 Southbound

• There will be mobile closures on the left and right lane of southbound I-75 between Clark Street to Springwells Street from April 21 to April 22, 2020, starting 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily.

Michigan Interchange I-75 Closures

As construction of the Michigan Interchange begins, Bridging North America will temporarily implement partial closures on the following streets for construction activities:

I-75 Southbound Service Drive

- The middle lane on southbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Clark Street exit ramp and Clark Street from March 9 April 30, 2020, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- The middle lane on southbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Dragoon Street and Livernois Avenue from March 9 April 30, 2020, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Clark Street

- Clark Street will close between Fort Street to I-75 Service Drive northbound from March 31 to May 8, 2020.
- The on-ramp and off-ramp at Clark Street and I-75 northbound will close from April 20 to May 9, 2020.

US Port of Entry (POE)

- Crews are continuing wick drain installation with approximately 34,000 complete out of 105,000 wick drains
- Continue import of surcharge material from I-75 excavation activities

Phase 2 US POE configuration remains. The perimeter of the site includes:

- Post St eastward to Dragoon St, and from Jefferson Ave northward to the Norfolk Southern Railroad tracks (NSR).
- Livernois Ave between South St to NSR and South St between Livernois Ave and Dragoon Street continues to remain open. Access will be maintained to adjacent properties.

US Bridge site

- The US Bridge team has completed installation of all drilled shafts
- Preparation for tower crane foundation work to begin in April
