Construction Activities - What you need to know

MICHIGAN INTERCHANGE 1-75

- ·As construction of the Michigan Interchange begins, Bridging North America will temporarily implement partial closures on Jefferson Avenue for construction activities. A section of the right shoulder on westbound Jefferson Avenue will close between Cavalry Street and Dearborn Street from January 6 - 24, 2020, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily.
- · Ongoing construction of staging areas, including laydown area between Campbell Street and Cavalry Street, south of Anthon Street. Sheet piling completed at Springwells Street and Livernois Ave; ongoing at Clark Street
- · Begin I-75 mainline and Service Drive demolition between Green Street and Springwells Street. Begin foundation piling at Springwells Street and Livernois Ave.

US BRIDGE

• The US Bridge team started installation of the 18 tower and the backspan 3m drilled shafts.

US POE

• Crews have begun wick drain installation with approx. 15,000 complete out of 105,000 wick drains and surcharge fill Utility relocation is complete within Phase I & II.

Phase 2 US POE configuration remains. The perimeter of the site includes:

- · Post St eastward to Dragoon St, and from Jefferson Ave northward to the Norfolk Southern Railroad tracks (NSR).
- Livernois Ave between South St to NSR and South St between Livernois Ave and Dragoon Street continues to remain open. Access will be maintained to adjacent properties

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Traffic updates - Continued

Bridging North America will permanently implement closures on these roadways on August 22, 2019, at 7 a.m. for the construction of the US Port of Entry (POE) of the Gordie Howe International Bridge.

- Waterman Street northbound and southbound between South Street and Norfolk Southern Railway
- Rademacher Street northbound and southbound between South Street to Norfolk Southern Railway
- Reid Street northbound and south-bound between South Street to Hesse Street
- Crawford Street northbound and southbound between South Street to Norfolk Southern Railway
- Livernois Avenue southbound be-tween South Street to Norfolk Southern Railway
- · Hesse Street eastbound and west-bound between Rademacher Street to Reid Street
- South Street eastbound and west-bound between Post Street to Dragoon Street

Detour routes have been provided for access around the construction zone.
