EMERGENCY DETOUR ALERT: Bridging North America has implemented a new detour on Woodmere
Street in response to the emergency closure of the Fort Street and Dearborn Street intersection.
Northbound motorists heading toward Springwells Street northbound will be detoured to Fort Street
eastbound/Melville Street eastbound, south on Green Street southbound, west on Jefferson Avenue
westbound, north on Dearborn Street northbound, north on Woodmere Street, east on Vernor Highway
eastbound, and then Springwells Street.

Fort Street

• The right lane of westbound Fort Street will close between Livernois Avenue and Dragoon Street, from February 7 until February 18, 2022, from 7 a.m. - 6 p.m. daily as needed.

• The right lane of eastbound Fort Street will close between Crawford Street and Livernois Avenue, from February 7 until February 18, 2022, from 7 a.m. - 6 p.m. daily as needed.

• BNA will not close the right lane of Fort Street in both directions at the same time. One side will close first, and then the other side until February 18, 2022, from 7 a.m. - 6 p.m. daily as needed.

Livernois Avenue

 Mobile closures will be on northbound and southbound Livernois Avenue between Fort Street and Lafayette Boulevard from February 14, 2022 until June 6, 2022, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. daily as needed.
 Only one lane will close. Closures will be less than 30 minutes in duration for mobilization and demobilization of equipment activities.

Clark Street

Clark Street will close between Fort Street and the I-75 Service Drive from February 28, 2022 until May 20, 2022 to support the reconstruction of the Clark Street approaches and intersections.
The Clark Street entrance-ramp to northbound I-75 and the Clark Street exit-ramp at southbound I-75 will be closed during construction from February 28, 2022 until May 20, 2022.





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I-75 Service Drive

• Northbound I-75 Service Drive is closed from Waterman Street to Dragoon Street until August 1, 2022.

Southbound I-75 Service Drive is closed from Waterman Street to Dragoon Street until August 1, 2022.

• I-75 Service Drive in both directions is closed between Clark Street and Dragoon Street until June 15, 2022. Junction Street will remain open to through traffic.

• Mobile closures will be extended on northbound and southbound I-75 Service Drives between Clark Street and Scotten Street and also Springwells Street to Central Street until April 29, 2022, between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. as needed. Only one lane will close. Closures will be less than 30 minutes in duration during these timeframes for mobilization and demobilization of equipment activities.

 Northbound and southbound I-75 Service Drive will close over a long-term period between Green Street and Waterman Street. Combined with pre-existing Service Drive closures in the area will make the entire northbound and southbound Service Drive closed from Springwells Street to Clark Street.
 The following road closures are in place;

Waterman Street between northbound and southbound I-75 Service Drives

- Dragoon Street between Fort Street and the southbound I-75 Service Drive
- Green Street between Fort Street and the southbound I-75 Service Drive.

I-75 Southbound - NEW

• The left two lanes of southbound I-75 will close between Junction Street and Clark Street from February 18, 2022, at 7 p.m. until February 21, 2022, at 5 a.m.

• The left land of southbound I-75 will remain closed between Springwells Street and McKinstry Street until June 6, 2022.

• The left lane of southbound I-75 will remain closed between Bagley Avenue and Junction Street until June 6, 2022.

I-75 Northbound - NEW

• The left two lanes of northbound I-75 will close between Junction Street and Clark Street from February 18, 2022, at 7 p.m. until February 21, 2022, at 5 a.m.

- The Livernois exit-ramp at Northbound I-75 will close over a long-term period, starting at 7 a.m. on June 15, 2021.
- The left lane of northbound I-75 will remain closed between Harbaugh Street and Clark Street until June 6, 2022.

Long Term I-75 Closures

As construction of the Michigan Interchange and the US Port of Entry (POE) continues, Bridging North America will extend the temporary closures along Livernois Avenue. Additionally, Cavalry Street and Military Street will remain closed over a long-term period. As a reminder, in July 2020, several streets closed over a long-term period including sections of Dragoon Street, Driggs Street, Harvey Street, Reeder Street and Hussar Street.

Cavalry Street

• Cavalry Street will remain closed over a long-term period between the northbound I-75 Service Drive and Fort Street.

Military Street

• Military Street will remain closed over a long-term period between the northbound I-75 Service Drive and Fort Street.

Livernois Avenue

• Livernois Avenue will remain closed between Fort Street and Norfolk Southern Railroad Tracks (open for local traffic only) until June 10, 2022.

- The Livernois Avenue ramps to north and southbound I-75 remain closed.
- The Livernois Avenue entrance-ramp at southbound I-75 remains closed.

Springwells Court

• Springwells Court northbound and southbound is closed west of the Lafarge entrance to east of the Springwells Court detour from May 15, 2021 until November 23, 2024.

Post Street

Post Street remains closed over a long-term period between CSX Railroad and the Delray Mechanical entrance.

Construction Activities

US Port of Entry (POE)

- Sheet pile installation is being completed to start excavation for manhole work on Harvey Street and Calvary Street.
- EPS block installation is being completed on Dragoon Street.
- Excavation for truck dock foundations, steel erection, detailing and decking work continues for the commercial building.

Crews are also building temporary enclosures to prepare for the grout under column application and ongoing underground work.

- Excavation and installation of the foundations continue for the main building.
- Layout work continues for the foundation for the outbound building.
- Surcharge removal work continues and material is being moved to the bridge abutment area.

US Bridge site

- Concrete, rebar and formwork continue to lift north and south towers.
- Modifications to the tower forms continue in preparation for the transition to the upper cross beam.
- Concrete, rebar and formwork continue to lift north and south piers and side span.
- Work continues on the lifts for the side span.

Construction Activities

Michigan Interchange

- Open cut excavation operations continue on Calvary Street.
- Form and rebar work continue for the junction chambers and elbows for north and southbound Campbell siphons.
- Structure excavation work continues at Green and at Beard and Waterman Streets.
- Storm sewer installations continue along the south and northbound Service Drive.
- Watermain installation continues along the southbound Service Drive.
- Installation of H-pile continues at the Green Street abutment.
- Concrete pile activities continue for bridge ramp work.
- Installation of light poles continue at Springwells and Livernois overpass bridges.
- · Local road exploratory and utility coordination continues this week.
