

Demolition Activity

Building demolition work is currently planned to occur along the Southbound I-75 Service Drive (between Crawford Street and Livernois Avenue), along the Southbound I-75 Service Drive (between Campbell Street and Junction Street), along Reid Street near the intersection of Holly Street, along Dragoon Street (between Fort Street and W. Jefferson Avenue), along Schroeder Street (between South Street and W. Jefferson Avenue), along Waterman Street (between South Street and W. Jefferson Avenue), along Military Street (between Fort Street and W. Jefferson Avenue), along Rademacher Street (between South Street and W. Jefferson Avenue), along Cavalry Street near the intersection of the Northbound I-75 Service Drive, along Fort Street (between Cavalry Street and Livernois Avenue) and along W. Jefferson Avenue between Cavalry Street and Rademacher Street. This work is not anticipated to impact traffic.



Preliminary Site Investigation (PSI)

PSI work is anticipated along Reeder St., Campbell St., Crawford St., Dragoon St., along Livernois Ave., Military St. and Harvey Street. This work is not anticipated to impact traffic.



Survey Activity Work

Survey work is anticipated Solvay Street (between Lafayette Boulevard and I-75), Crawford Street, W. Jefferson Avenue (between Harrington Street and Post Street), Post Street (between W. Jefferson Avenue and South Street) and Harrington Street (between Gould Street and W. Jefferson Avenue). This work is not anticipated to impact traffic.



Temporary Road Closures

Utility work is expected along the Northbound and Southbound I-75 Service Drives (between Rademacher Street and Waterman Street), Junction Street (between Driggs Street and Fort Street) and Rademacher Street (between W. Jefferson Avenue and I-75). Intermittent lane closures are anticipated at these locations.
