#### **Demolition Activity**

Building demolition work is currently planned to occur along Campbell Street (between Lauderdale Street and Driggs Street), Crawford Street (between Holly Street and W. Jefferson Avenue), Military Street (between W. Jefferson Avenue and W. Fort Street), W. Fort Street (between Military Street and Crawford Street), Dragoon Street (between I-75 and Fort Street), the South Bound I-75 Service Drive (between Junction Street and Wilde Street), South Street (between Rademacher Street and Crawford Street), Rademacher Street (between W. Fort Street and South Street) and Reid Street (between W. Jefferson Avenue and the railroad tracks). This work is not anticipated to impact traffic.



#### Preliminary Site Investigation (PSI)

PSI work is anticipated along Fort Street (between Crawford Street and Campbell Street), the South Bound I-75 Service Drive (between McKinstry Street and Clark Street), and Wilde Street (between I-75 and Fort Street). This work is not anticipated to impact traffic



### Survey Activity Work

No survey field work is planned.



#### **Temporary Road Closures**

Utility work is expected along Livernois Avenue (between Fort Street and the railroad tracks), Rademacher Street (between the South Bound I-75 Service Drive and Fort Street) and at the intersection of Junction Street and Fort Street. Intermittent lane closures are anticipated at these locations. Utility work is also occurring along Junction Street (between Fort Street and the North Bound I-75 Service Drive), under a full road closure with a posted detour.
