

### **Demolition Activity**

Building demolition work is currently planned to occur along Beard St. (between W. Lafayette and S. Fisher Freeway Service Drive), along S. Rademacher Street (between South Street and W. Jefferson Avenue), along Lewerenz Street. (between W. Fisher Fwy. and W. Fort St.), and along Military St. (between W. Fisher Fwy. and W. Fort St). This work is not anticipated to impact traffic.

Tree cutting and clearing will begin on multiple parcels throughout the footprint.



### **Preliminary Site Investigation (PSI)**

PSI work is scheduled to occur along W. Fisher Fwy. (between Junction Street and Campbell Street), along W. Jefferson Avenue (between Green Street and Harrington Street), along W. Jefferson Avenue (between S. Post Street and Schroeder Street), along Schroeder Street (between W. Jefferson Avenue and South Street), along W. Jefferson Avenue (between S. Livernois Avenue and S. Crawford Street), along W. Jefferson Avenue (between S. Livernois Avenue and Dragoon Street), along Rademacher Street (between South Street and W. Jefferson Avenue), along S. Post Street (between South Street and W. Jefferson Avenue), along Casgrain Street (between W. Fisher Fwy. and W. Fort Street), along W. Fort Street (between Crawford Street and Livernois Avenue) and along Rademacher Street (between South Street and Norfolk Southern RR). This work is not anticipated to impact traffic.



## **Survey Activity Work**

Survey work is scheduled to occur at several sites throughout the footprint. Staking on parcel and alley lines will be ongoing in the area east of Post Street and north of Jefferson Ave. Staking will also be ongoing along the NB and SB I-75 Service Drives from Springwells Street to Clark Street for tree removal. Contingency survey work may also occur at other sites throughout the footprint. No lane closures are expected.



### **Utility Work**

Mobile lane closures are expected on Fort Street (between Clark Street and Springwells Street) for utility facilities inspection.

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
