

Demolition Activity

Building demolition work is currently planned to occur along W. Jefferson Ave. (between Military St. and Dragoon St.), along S. Harrington St. (between Gould St. and W. Jefferson Ave.), along W. Fort St. (between Post St. and Waterman St.), along Livernois St. (between South St. and the railroad tracks), along W. Fort St. (between Glinnan St. and Springwells St.), along W. Fort St. (between Post St. and Campbell St.), along W. Fort St. (between Cavalry St. and Campbell St.), along SB I-75 Service Dr. (between Morrell St. and Junction St.), along Military St. (between W. Jefferson Ave. and the railroad tracks). Intermittent lane closures are expected along various streets throughout the footprint. Turf restoration is also occurring on several parcels throughout the footprint.



Preliminary Site Investigation (PSI)

PSI work is scheduled in the ROW in various areas throughout the project. Work will be occurring in the north and south interchange areas as well as throughout the plaza area. Seeding and mulching may also be ongoing at various parcels throughout the footprint. This work is not anticipated to impact traffic.



Survey Activity Work

Crews will be conducting site survey work throughout project footprint, along I-75 and the North and South Service Drives. Geotechnical work will occur near Springwells Court and the Lafarge area. Contingent intermittent survey work may be required for various parcels throughout the entire project area.



Utility Work

The SB Fisher Service Dr. will be closed (between Scotten St. and Clark St.) for gas main installation. The SB I-75 off-ramp will also be closed. A detour will be in place for local residents to provide access. The NB I-75 Service Dr. will also be closed at Rademacher St. for gas main work. A detour will be in place. Utility work will also be occurring along W. Jefferson Ave. between Schroeder St. and Post St. with the right parking lane closed. Tree cutting and miscellaneous debris removal will also be occurring throughout the footprint.

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
