As part of his visit, Minister Sohi stopped to tour the future site of the Canadian Port of Entry where he had the opportunity to see first-hand the Early Works activities currently underway. At the site, he cut one of the 45,000 wicks that are being installed and placed fill on top as one of the last steps in the wick drain installation process.

Holiday Office Hours


