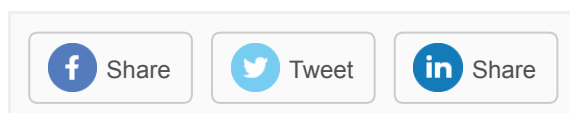
Drone Footage
