Utility Relocation

The second phase of the Preparatory Activities at the Canadian POE which will see the relocation of a complex network of high-voltage electrical distribution and transmission lines to underground and to new overhead locations is well underway. The lines need to be relocated to make room for the new bridge span and POE. Relocation of these lines is a complicated task. The work, worth an estimated \$86 million, includes the removal of nine hydro towers and over 7.5 kilometres (4.7 miles) of new high-transmission voltage cable contained in more than three kilometres (approximately two miles) of utility ducts.
