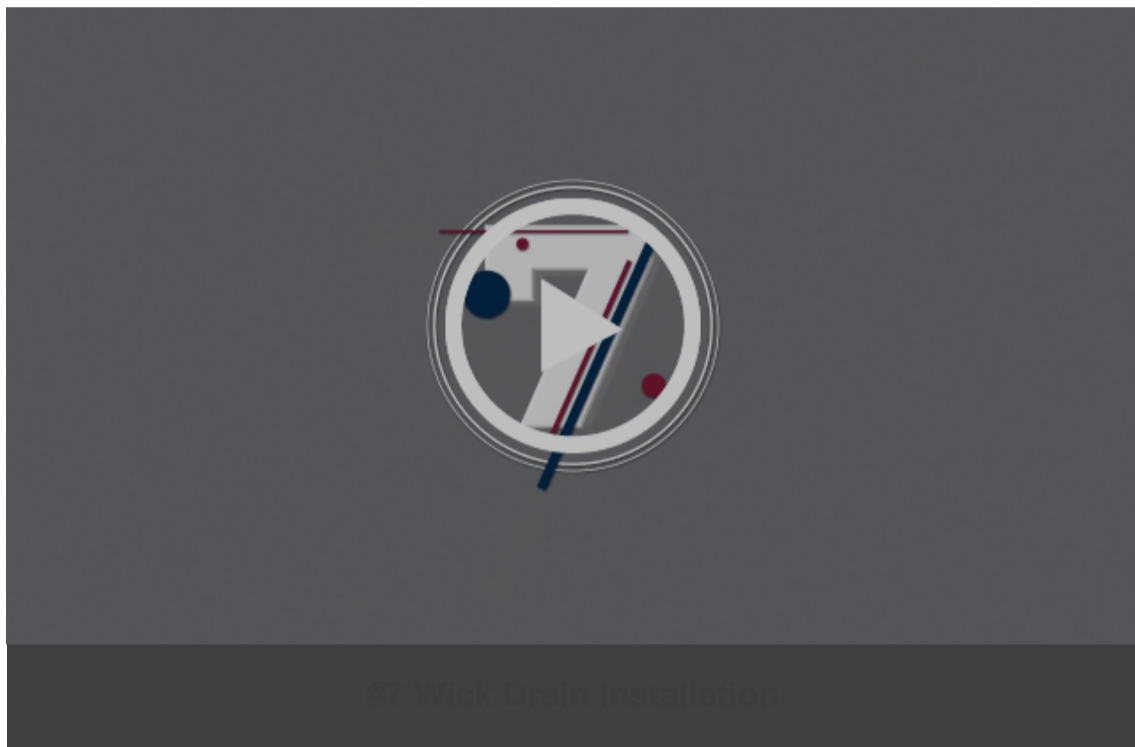

2019 has been a busy year for the Gordie Howe International Bridge project with many accomplishments. As construction progresses for the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, we will temporarily implement partial closures of Interstate-75 for pavement-marking operations, Friday, December 13, 2019, through Saturday, December 14, 2019.

- The Ambassador Bridge ramp to I-75 southbound will close Friday, December 13 at 9:00 p.m. until Saturday, December 14, at 9:00 a.m. During this period, travelers can take I-96 west to US 12, then back to I-75 Service Drive southbound to I-75 southbound.
- Intermittent lane closures will take place on southbound I-75 between Vernor Highway and Springwells Street starting at 9:00 p.m. Friday, December 13, until 2:00 a.m. Saturday, December 14.
- The on-ramp at I-75 southbound Service Drive and 24th Street will close from, from 2:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Saturday, December 14.
- The exit ramp at I-75 southbound and Clark Street will close from 2:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Saturday, December 14.

This program will provide an annual \$50,000 (CDN) investment allowance to community organizations located in or servicing Sandwich/West Windsor or Delray/Southwest Detroit residents from 2020 – 2024.

Eligible organizations can submit funding applications until **January 31, 2020** ranging from \$1,000 and \$25,000 (CDN) for events, programming and infrastructure improvements that will benefit the neighbourhoods located closest to the project.
