



PONT INTERNATIONAL GORDIE HOWE INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE

Good afternoon,

We have a few project updates to share:



As construction of the Michigan Interchange begins for the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, we require the temporary closure of Interstate-75 in both directions from Springwells Street to Clark Street beginning Friday, December 6, 2019, at approximately 11:00 p.m. to allow for demolition of three road bridges. Lanes will re-open by 5:00 a.m. Monday, December 9, 2019.



DETOUR ROUTES

Local traffic can continue to exit northbound I-75 at Springwells Street and enter northbound I-75 at Clark Street. Southbound I-75 traffic can exit at Clark Street and enter southbound I-75 at Springwells Street.

West Fisher Service Drives between Springwells and Clark, on both sides of the Interstate, will remain open.

Regional traffic traveling toward Detroit from Toledo, Ohio on I-75 will be directed to take I-275 north to I-96, then I-96 east in order to reconnect with northbound I-75.

Traffic traveling to Toledo from Auburn Hills, Michigan on I-75 will be directed to take I-96 west to I-275, then I-275 south in order to reconnect with southbound I-75.

Traffic exiting the Ambassador Bridge toll plaza and traveling to Toledo will be directed to take I-96 west to I-275 south in order to connect with southbound I-75.

The Gordie Howe International Bridge project between Windsor, ON and Detroit, MI will help move goods and people more efficiently at this important trade gateway. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA), working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public-private partnership (P3) which will see Bridging North America design, build, finance, operate and maintain the bridge

2020 COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION INVESTMENT APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN



Applications are now open for the 2020 **Community Organization Investment** initiative as part of the Community Benefits Plan. The Neighbourhood Infrastructure Strategy includes a commitment to provide a **\$50,000** (CDN) annual investment allowance for community organizations located in or servicing Sandwich/West Windsor or Delray/Southwest Detroit for a five-year duration from **2020 – 2024**.

Eligible organizations can submit funding applications until **January 31, 2020** for proposed initiatives ranging from **\$1,000 and \$25,000** (CDN) for events, programming and infrastructure improvements that will benefit the Sandwich/West Windsor or Delray/Southwest Detroit neighbourhoods.

Applications will undergo a thorough review process and will only be considered for funding if eligibility requirements are met.
