Upcoming Road Closures



Occasional traffic disruptions are required as part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project. We wanted to keep you updated on a few traffic disruptions that we have planned for the coming weeks so that you can plan accordingly.

Week of May 6, 2019

- The left lane and left shoulder of northbound I-75 Service Drive will be closed between Rademacher Street and Green Street May 4, 2019, to May 7, 2019, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily.
- The right lane of southbound Junction Street will be closed between the Fisher Service Drive and Fort Street May 6, 2019, to May 10, 2019, from 8 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily.
- The left lane and left shoulder of northbound I-75 will be closed between Fort Street and Springwells Street May 11, 2019, to May 13, 2019, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily.

As a reminder the following roads are subject to long-term closures between South Street and Jefferson including:

- Schroeder Street
- Waterman Street
- Rademacher Street
- Reid Street
- Crawford Street
- Livernois Avenue
- Holly Street
- Beulow Court.
