Upcoming Temporary Road Closures in Southwest Detroit



Occasional traffic disruptions are required as part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project. We wanted to keep you updated on a few traffic disruptions that we have planned for the coming weeks so that you can plan accordingly.

Week of May 27, 2019

- The left lane of westbound I75 Service Drive between Campbell Street to Dragoon will be closed May 28, 2019, to May 30, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily.
- The westbound lane of Jefferson Avenue between Dearborn Street to Anderson Street will be closed May 28, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The northbound lanes of Military Street between Jefferson Avenue to Fort Street will be closed May 29, 2019 to May 31, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily.
- The right lane of eastbound Fort Street between Livernois Avenue to Dragoon Street will be closed May 29, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The westbound lane of Jefferson Avenue between Anderson Street to Post Street will be closed May 29, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The left lane of northbound I75 Service Drive between Solvay Avenue and Green Street will be closed May 29, 2019, to May 30, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily
- The right lane of eastbound Fort Street between Dragoon Street to Military Street will be closed May 30, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The westbound lane of Jefferson Avenue between Post Street to Rademacher Street will be closed May 30, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The right lane of northbound I75 Service Drive between Westend Street to Glinnan Street will be closed May 30, 2019 to May 31, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily.
- The right lane of eastbound Fort Street between Military Street to Cavalary Street will be closed May 31, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The westbound lane of Jefferson Avenue between Rademacher Street to Military Street will be closed May 31, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The right lane of westbound Fort Street between Cavalary Street to Military Street will be closed June 1, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The southbound lanes of Military Street between Fort Street to Hussar Street will be closed June 1, 2019 to June 2, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily.
- The eastbound lane of Jefferson Avenue between Junction Street to Military Street June 2, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The right lane of westbound Fort Street between Dragoon Street to Livernois Avenue will be closed June 2, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The northbound I75 exit ramp to Livernois Avenue will be closed June 3, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The eastbound lane of Jefferson Avenue between Military Street to Rademacher Street June 3, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
