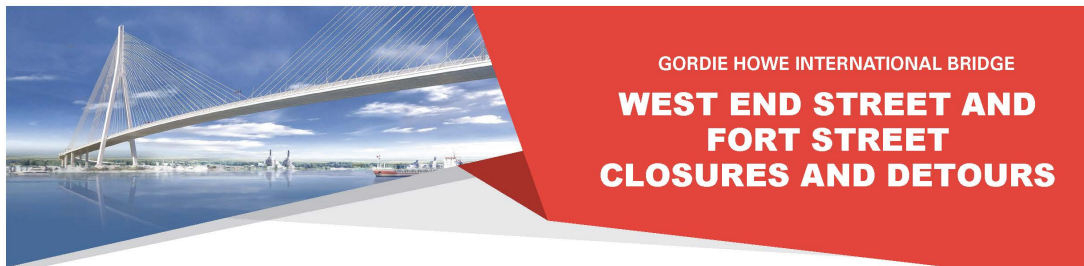
- workforce development and participation strategy highlights and accomplishments

THE PROJECT

The Gordie Howe International Bridge project between Windsor, ON and Detroit, MI will help move goods and people more efficiently at this important trade gateway. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public-private partnership (P3) which will see Bridging North America design, build, finance, operate and maintain the bridge.

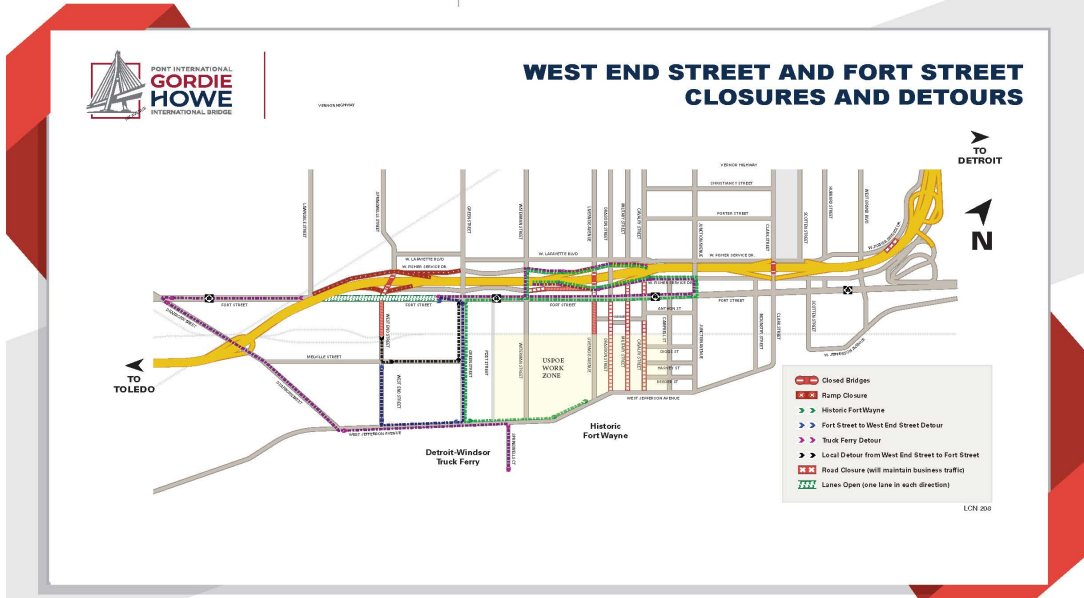
UPCOMING CLOSURES AND DETOURS

As construction of the Michigan Interchange continues, Bridging North America will temporarily close several streets, including West End Street and two lanes on Fort Street, from July 13 until October 9, 2020.

West End Street will be closed between Fort Street and Melville Street, with local access only.

Traffic on Fort Street, east of Glinnan Street and west of Springwells Street, will be reduced to one lane each for westbound and eastbound traffic.

The lane closure on Fort Street will maintain business access and mobility.
