Progress and Partnerships Continue on the Gordie Howe International Bridge Project

Two years ago today, Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) announced that it had signed a \$5.7 billion (CDN) fixed-priced contract with Bridging North America (BNA), its private-sector partner to design, build, finance, operate and maintain the Gordie Howe International Bridge project. That announcement signified that construction could begin on one of the largest infrastructure projects in North America and milestones on all four components of the project have been achieved since then. Significant construction progress and our work with communities on both sides of the border continue despite the challenging times being faced worldwide as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Traffic Update

Bridging North America will temporarily close several streets, including West End Street and three lanes on Fort Street including the center median.

- West End Street will be closed between Fort Street and Melville Street, from September 29 to November 20, 2020. Local traffic and business traffic will have access to West End Street between Norfolk Southern Railroad to Melville Street.
- Traffic on Fort Street, between the northbound I-75 Service Drive and Wheelock Street, will be reduced to one lane each for westbound and eastbound traffic from September 29 to November 20, 2020.
- Temporary pavement markings will be installed on Fort Street on September 29 2020, between 6am and 6pm, and on October 28, 2020, between 6am and 6pm.

Detour routes include:

West End Street Detour
Local motorists traveling northbound on West End Street will be detoured east on Melville Street, north on Green Street and west on Fort Street.

West Jefferson Avenue Detour
Motorists on West Jefferson Avenue will be detoured north on Green Street and West on Fort Street.

Fort Street Detour
Motorists on Fort Street will be detoured south on Green Street and west on West Jefferson Avenue. This detour will be utilized by Historic Fort Wayne Traffic to access West Jefferson Avenue. Detroit Truck Ferry traffic will be detoured west on Fort Street, south on Dearborn Street and east on West Jefferson Avenue.
