WDBA and the Art Gallery of Windsor partner to launch *Bridge Artists* exhibit

A partnership between Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority and the Art Gallery of Windsor that celebrates historical and cultural aspects of the region is launching August 12, 2021, with a unique art exhibition. The *Bridge Artists* exhibit will feature art from the Anishinaabe artists Teresa Altman and Daisy White of Walpole Island First Nation and Naomi Peters of Caldwell First Nation who created the art on the bridge tower forms at the Canadian project site in 2020. A 20-foot scale model of the Gordie Howe International Bridge is also showcased as part of the exhibit.

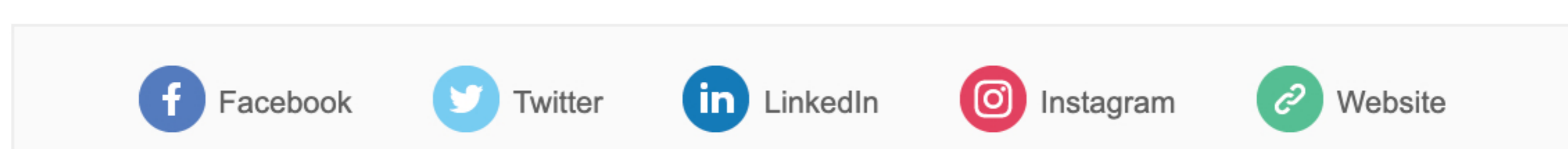
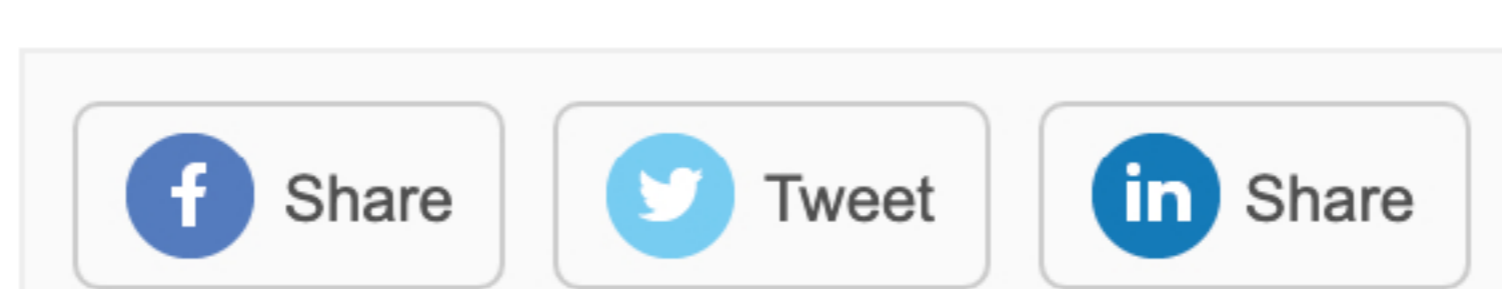
