included the Delray Home Improvement Program in the Community Benefits Plan for the project. The program represents a \$4 million (CDN) investment to help residents undertake home repairs to properties located in Delray, Detroit. The program boundaries are:

- Interstate-75 (I-75) to the north
- Clark Avenue/South Clark Street to the east
- West End Street to the west
- West Jefferson Avenue to the south.



Applications are now being accepted online or through paper submissions that will be mailed to eligible households in early 2021

Successful applicants may receive items from the pre-approved repair/replacement list, based on an assessment of the home, with a per-house cap of \$20,000 (USD). Improvements offered include:


- roof repair and/or roof replacement
- window and/or door replacement
- roof insulation and/or wall insulation
 - repair or replacement of heating, ventilation, and/or air-conditioning (HVAC) unit.
