Upcoming Traffic Disruptions in Southwest Detroit

There are a number of upcoming road closures that we wanted to make you aware of.

Northbound I-75:

- The left lane will close on northbound I-75 between Harbaugh Street and Clark Street from March 7 - January 31, 2022.
- The right lane on northbound I-75 will remain closed between Springwells Street and Clark Street until March 22, 2021.

Southbound I-75:

- Three right lanes will close from Lansing Street to Springwells Street from March 12 - 13, 2021.
- All lanes of the Clark on-ramp at southbound I-75 will be closed from March 12 - 13, 2021.
- Three left lanes will close on Southbound I-75 from Lansing Street to Springwells Street from March 13 - 14, 2021.
- The right lane of southbound I-75 will close between Bagley Avenue and McKinstry Street from March 14 - June 30, 2021.
- The left lane of southbound I-75 will close between Springwells Street and McKinstry Street from March 14, 2021, to January 31, 2022.
- The right lane of southbound I-75 will remain closed between Clark Street and Springwells Street until March 22, 2021.

I-75 Service Drive:

Bridging North America will extend the temporary closure of the following lanes and streets to support the watermain relocation work at southbound I-75 Service Drive between Junction Street and Clark Street.

The following streets will remain closed to through traffic at southbound I-75 Service Drive until March 22, 2021, from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. daily as needed:

- Morrell Street
- Ferdinand Street
- Lansing Street
- McKinstry Street

The right lane of the southbound I-75 Service Drive will remain closed until March 22, 2021, from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. daily as needed, in the following locations:

- Between Morrell Street and Ferdinand Street
- Between Morrell Street and Lansing Street
- Ferdinand Street and McKinstry Street
- Lansing Street and Clark Street

- The left lane and middle lane of the southbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Ferdinand Street to Clark Street from March 9 - 15, 2021, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily as needed.
- The right lane and middle lane of the southbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Ferdinand Street to Clark Street from March 9 - 15, 2021, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily as needed.
- One lane will remain open at all times for through-traffic on southbound I-75 Service Drive.

Vernor Highway:

- The Vernor Highway on-ramp to southbound I-75 will be closed from March 14, 2021, to July 7, 2021.

Campbell Street:

- Bridging North America will temporarily close the following lanes and streets and modify traffic patterns to support the watermain relocation work at Campbell Street.
- Campbell Street will close to through traffic at the southbound I-75 Service Drive, starting March 15 - 22, 2021.
- Campbell Street between southbound I-75 Service Drive and Amherst Street will be converted to two-way traffic during this closure.
- The right lane of southbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Campbell Street and Junction Street, starting March 15 - 22, 2021.

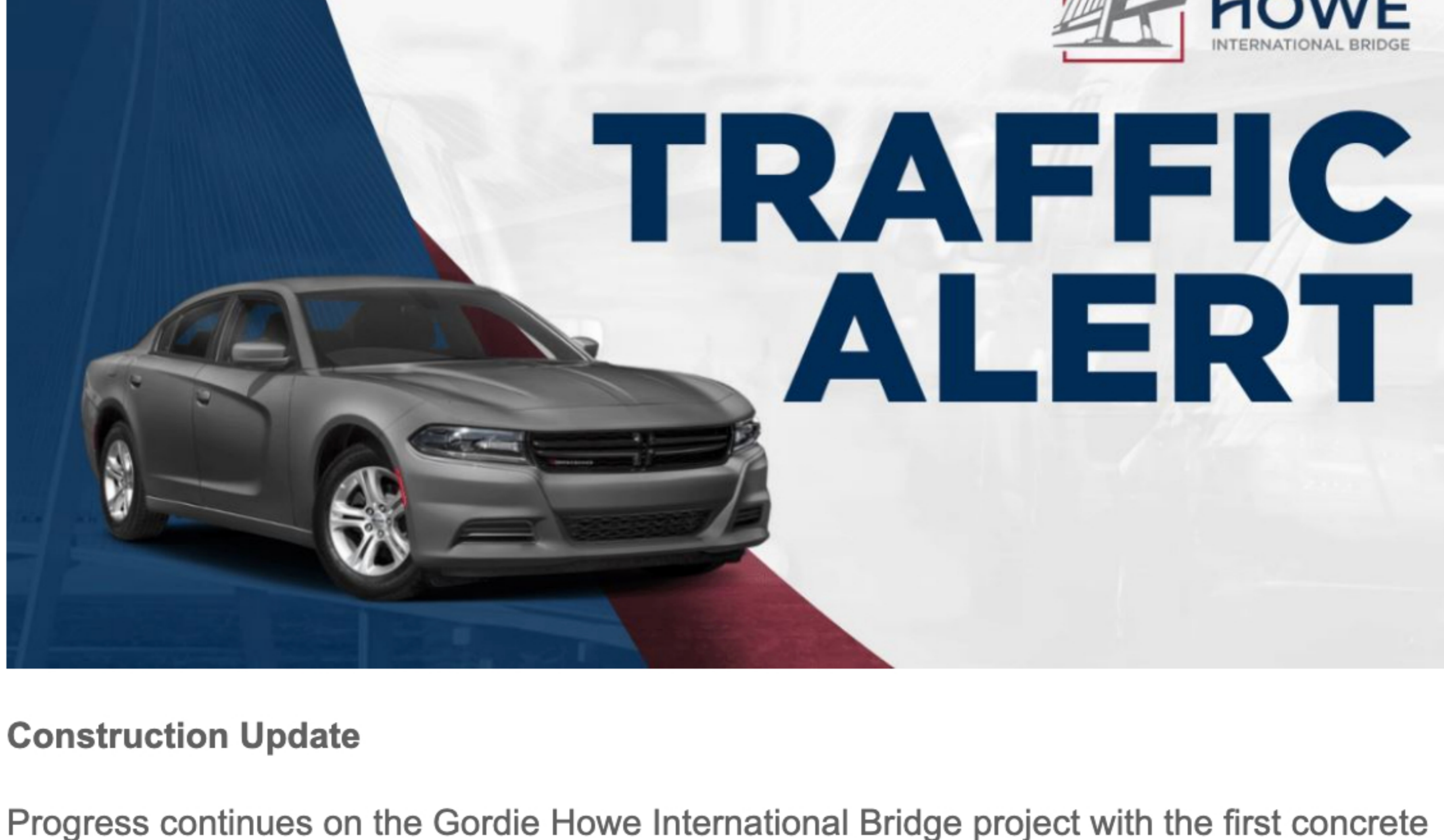
Military Street:

Bridging North America will extend the temporary closure of the following lanes and streets to support the watermain relocation work at the I-75 Service Drive and Military Street.

- Military Street will be closed between the southbound I-75 Service Drive and Lafayette Boulevard from March 8 - 15, 2021 between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., daily as needed.
- The right lane of southbound I-75 Service Drive will be closed at Military Street from March 8 - 15, 2021 between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., daily as needed.

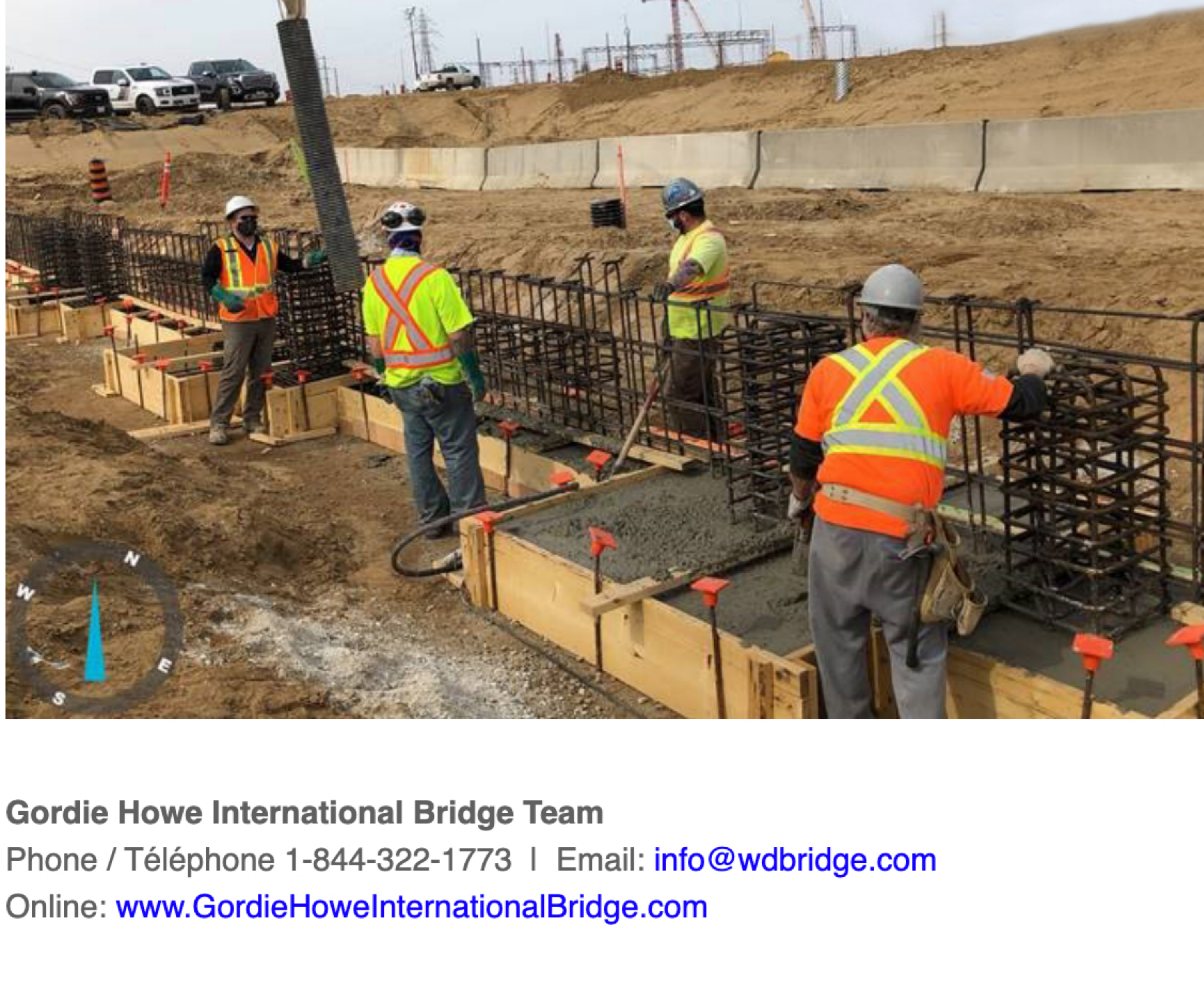
Junction Street:

- Junction Street will remain closed at the southbound I-75 Service Drive until March 19, 2021, to support the watermain relocation work.



Construction Update

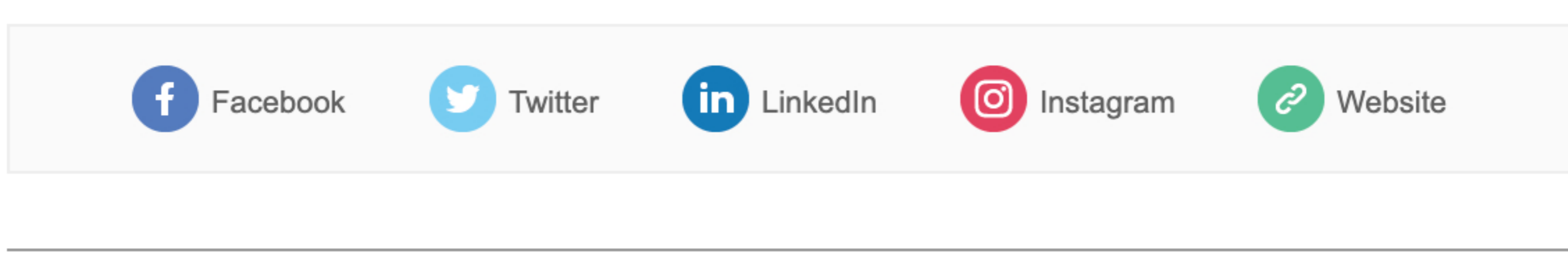
