1 MULTI-USE PATH

Design requirements revised to include a dedicated multi-use path for pedestrians and cyclists.



2 NEW TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION GAS LINES

4.3 kilometres of new transmission and distribution natural gas pipeline installed at the Canadian Port of Entry.

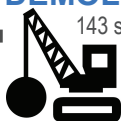
3 BOARD OF DIRECTORS

WDBA's Board of Directors expanded from 5 to 9 members.



4 DEMOLITION

143 structures demolished on required US lands under MDOT's control.



5 PROPERTY ACQUISITION

\$30 million in agreements with City of Detroit for purchase of property, leases and services.

6 STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

150 meetings and events with stakeholders, businesses and residents.



7 ELECTRICAL RELOCATION

\$86 million in contracts awarded for electrical relocation work.



8 PROPONENT PROGRESSION

More than 60 commercially confidential meetings with Proponent Teams to support the preparation of their proposals.

9 ENGINEERING PROJECT OF THE YEAR

Recipient of the 2017 Engineering Project of the Year Award presented at the 10th Global Infrastructure Leadership Forum.
