

Happy New Year

Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority wishes you a happy New Year. We will be closed January 1, 2021. Regular business hours will resume on January 4, 2021.



Traffic Updates

As construction of the Michigan Interchange continues, Bridging North America will close several streets in southwest Detroit starting on Monday, January 4, 2021.

West End Street and Fort Street


Bridging North America has temporarily closed several streets, including West End Street and three lanes on Fort Street. These closures have been extended, with the updated information below.

Details:

- West End Street will remain closed between Fort Street and Melville Street until April 20, 2021. Local traffic and business traffic will access West End Street via Norfolk Southern Railroad to Melville Street.
- Traffic on Fort Street between the northbound I-75 Service Drive and Central Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction for westbound and eastbound traffic from January 4, 2021, to March 1, 2021.

Detours:

- Local motorists traveling northbound on West End Street will be detoured east on Melville Street, north on Green Street and west on Fort Street.
- Motorists on West Jefferson Avenue will be detoured north on Green Street and West on Fort Street.
- · Motorists on Fort Street will be detoured south on Green Street and west on West Jefferson Avenue. This detour will be utilized by Historic Fort Wayne Traffic to access West Jefferson Avenue.
- Detroit Truck Ferry traffic will be detoured west on Fort Street, south on Dearborn Street and east on West Jefferson Avenue.



Campbell Street

Bridging North America will temporarily close the following lanes and streets and modify traffic patterns to support watermain relocation work at Campbell Street.

Details:

- Campbell Street will close to through traffic at the southbound I-75 Service Drive, starting January 4 - 11, 2021. Campbell Street between southbound I-75 Service Drive and Amherst Street will be converted to two-way traffic during this closure.
- The right lane of southbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Campbell Street and Junction Street, starting January 4 to 11, 2021.
- Campbell Street will be closed between the northbound I-75 Service Drive and alley from January 4 to 8, 2021, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily as needed.
- The right lane of northbound I-75 Service Drive will be closed at Campbell Street from January 4 to 8, 2021, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily as needed.

Detour:

 Northbound I-75 Service Drive motorists will be detoured south on Junction Street southbound, west to Fort Street westbound, then to Campbell Street.

I-75 Service Drive

Bridging North America will temporarily close the northbound I-75 Service Drive for siphon work at Cavalry Street. Access will be maintained to the on-ramp at Dragoon Street to northbound I-75.

Details:

 Northbound I-75 Service Drive will close between Dragoon Street and Campbell Street over a long-term period starting at 7 a.m. on January 11, 2021, for siphon work at Cavalry Street. Access will be maintained to the on-ramp at Dragoon Street to northbound I-75.


Detour:

• Traffic heading east on the northbound I-75 Service Drive will head south on Livernois, east on Fort Street, north on Junction Street to the northbound I-75

Service Drive. Access will be maintained to the on-ramp at Dragoon Street to northbound I-75.
