

GORDIE HOWE INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE EXTENDED TO JULY 9, 2021

WEST END STREET AND FORT STREET STREET CLOSURES AND DETOURS

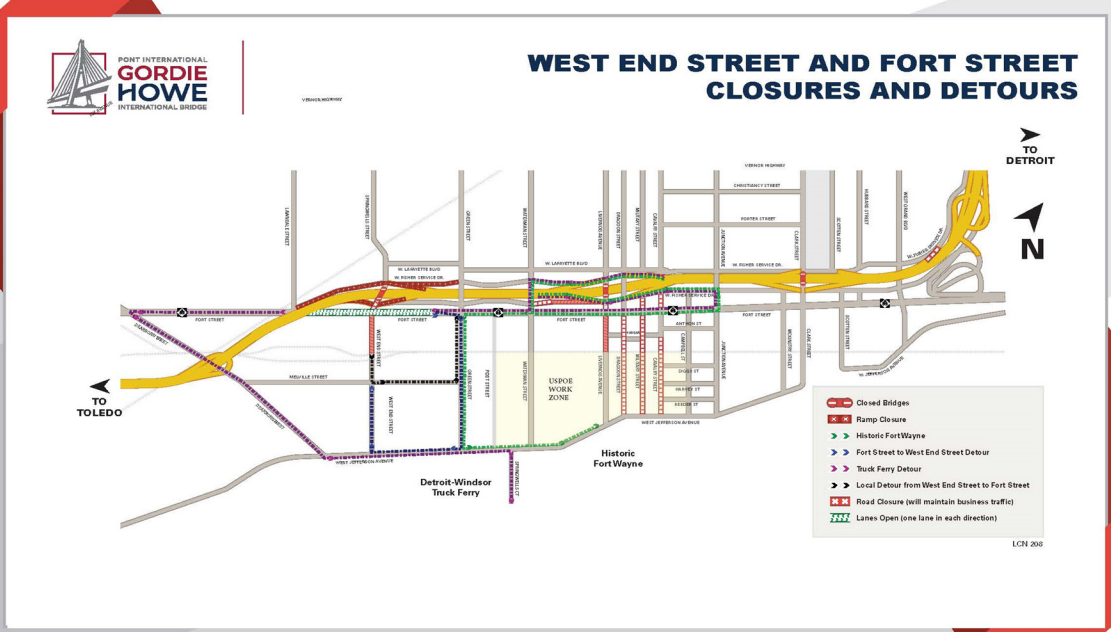
THE PROJECT

The Gordie Howe International Bridge project between Windsor, ON and Detroit, MI will help move goods and people more efficiently at this important trade gateway. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public-private partnership (P3) which will see Bridging North America design, build, finance, operate and maintain the bridge.

As construction of the Michigan Interchange continues, Bridging North America has temporarily closed several streets, including West End Street and three lanes on Fort Street. This closure will be used to construct West End Street and tie-in the newly aligned Springwells Bridge, near the Fort Street intersection.

DETAILS:

- West End street will remain closed between Fort Street and Melville Street until July 9, 2021. Local traffic and business traffic will have access to West End street between Norfolk Southern Railroad to Melville Street.
